Pennsylvania Brings in \$2.34 Billion in Revenue Collections

General Fund revenue collections for the month of November were \$2.34 billion, which was \$95 million more than the Department of Revenue's Official Estimate.

Collections of \$138 million for corporation taxes came in above the Official Revenue Estimate projections by \$27 million. Sales tax collections of \$910 million were higher than expected, coming in \$45 million above the Official Estimate. The Personal Income Taxes collected were \$835 million, which was below estimate by \$30 million.

For the 2018-19 Fiscal Year, General Fund collections of \$12.36 billion are above the official estimate by \$333.6 million or 2.77%.
